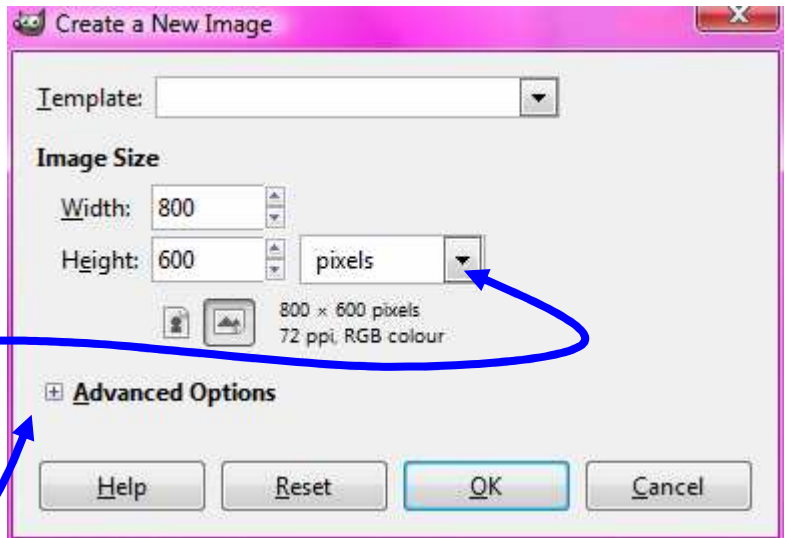


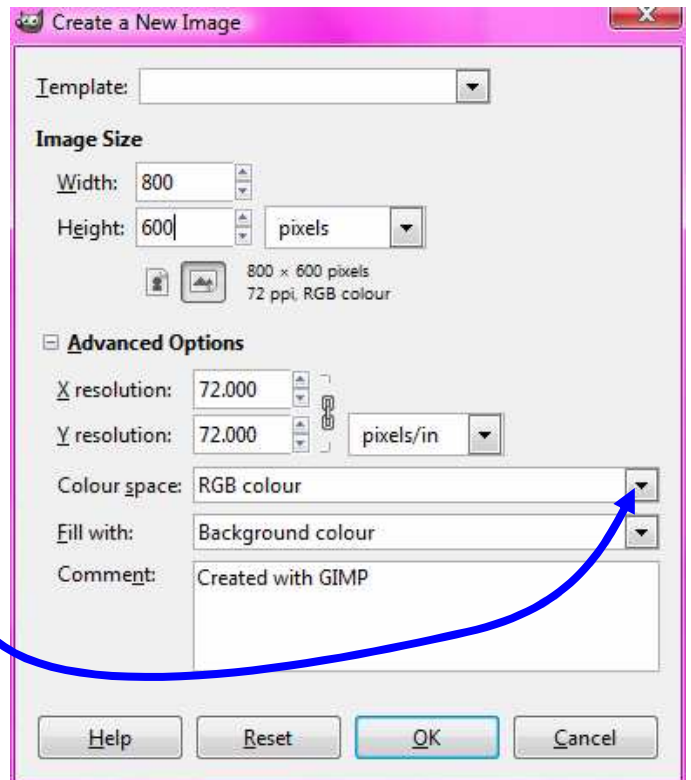
# GIMP Making Hotspots

- Load GIMP and go to **File | New...** the following window appears:
- Adjust the **Width** to **800** and the **Height** to **600** (make sure your unit of measurement is **pixels**)
- Click the plus sign by **Advanced Options**



The following appears:

- Click the arrow here and in the options that appear select **White**. Click the **OK** button



- Now click on the **Text Tool**  and type in the title, "Fast and Furious"



Your typing will appear in this window:



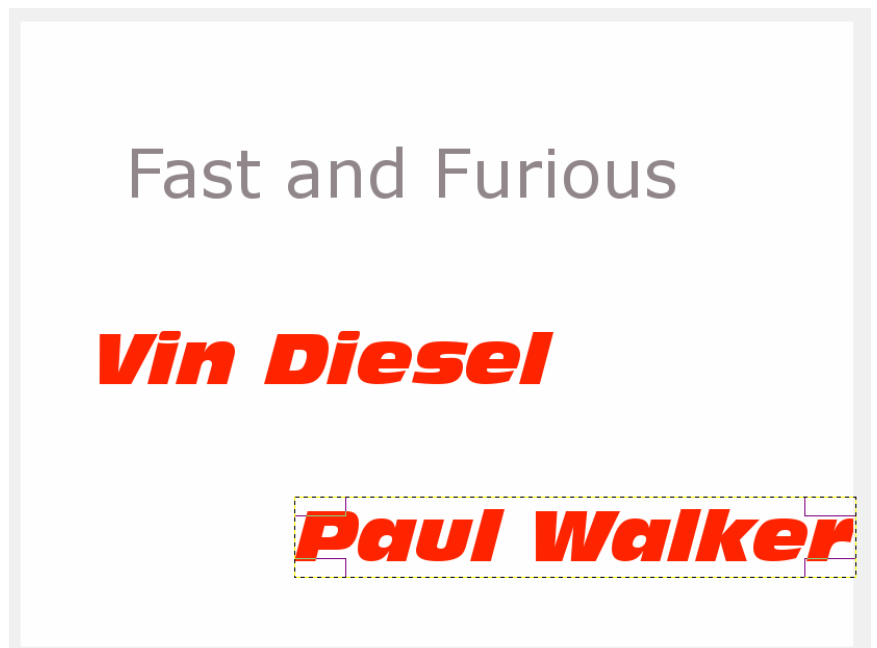
You can adjust the colour and size of the text here:

- Once you are happy with your text, click the **Close** button



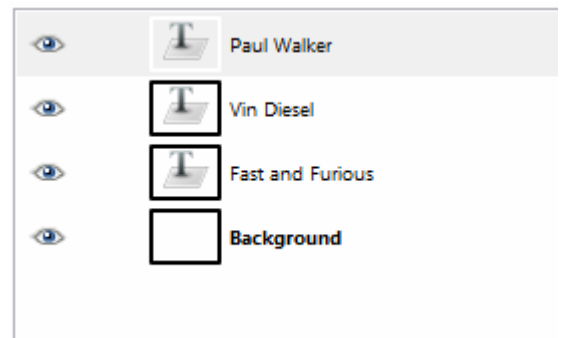
- Now click on the **Text Tool**  again and type in, "Vin Diesel." Adjust the colour and size to what you want.
- Click on the **Text Tool**  again and type in, "Paul Walker." Again adjust the size and colour to what you want

Here is what I ended up with:

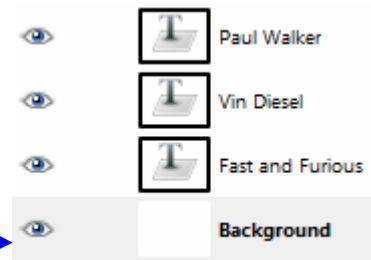



Your **Layers Menu** will look like this:

- Click on the **Background Layer** to select it



- Your **Layers Menu** will now look like this:



- Now click on the **Free Select Tool**  and draw a shape:




The **Foreground Colour** at present is probably black:

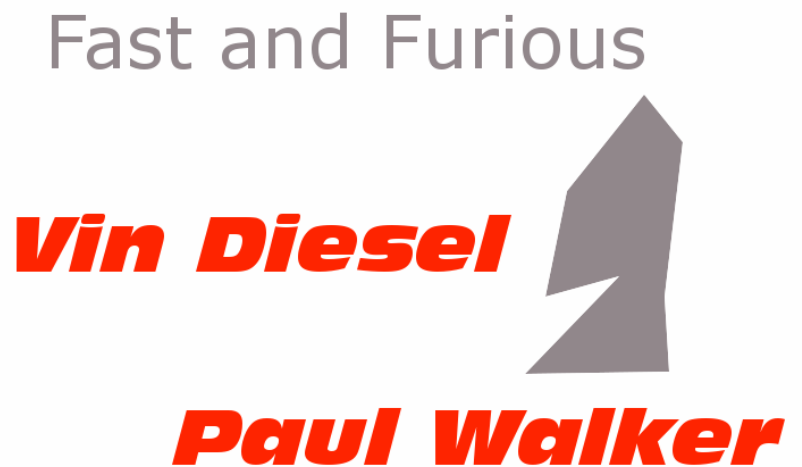


- Double click on it and select a colour of your choice:

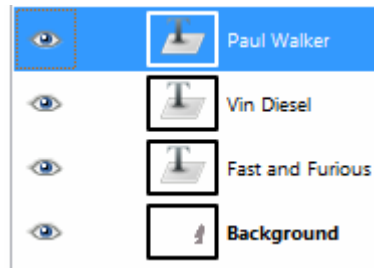



- Click on the **Bucket Fill Tool**  and then click on the centre of your shape
- Go to **Select | None**

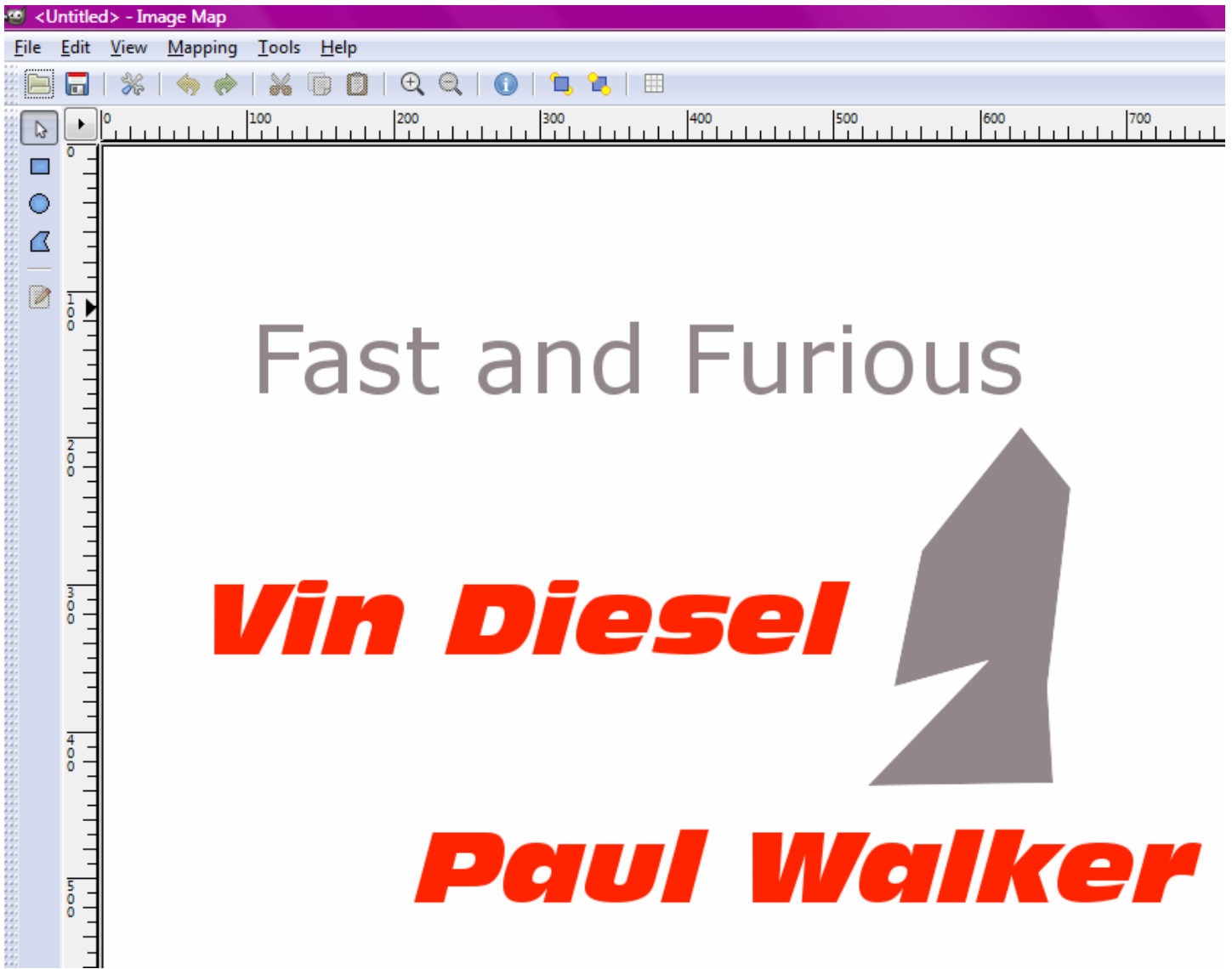
You should end up with something like this:



- Click on the top Layer:



- Go to **Layer | Merge Down** and keep doing this until you have only one layer left: 
- Go to **File | Save as...** and save it as FastAndFurious.jpg (click **Export** and **Save** in the subsequent windows)
- Go to **Filters | Web | Image Map...** The following appears:

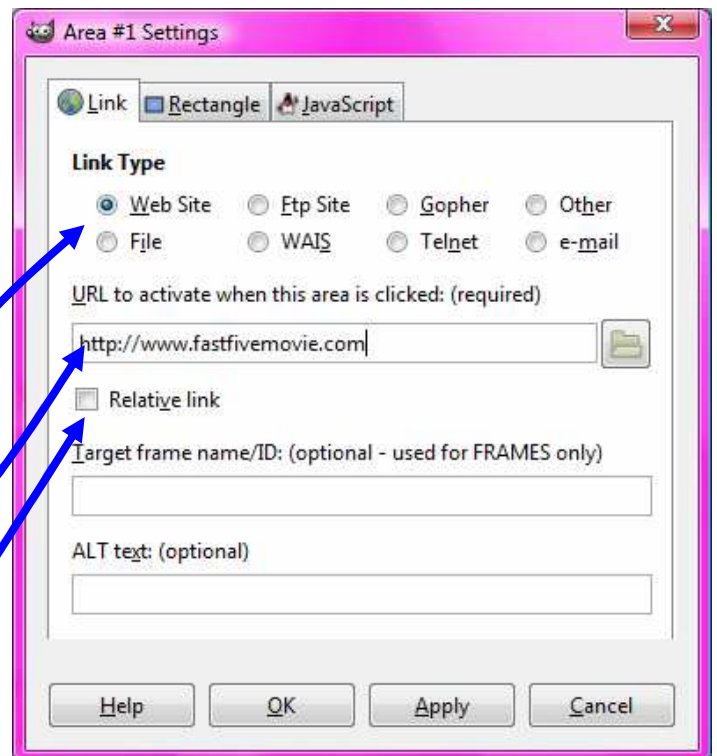


Maximise the window

- Click on the **Define Rectangle Area** Tool and draw a rectangle around Fast and Furious – double click to finish the rectangle

The following window appears:

- Click **Website**
- Type in the address here:
- Untick the **Relative link** box
- Click the **OK** button

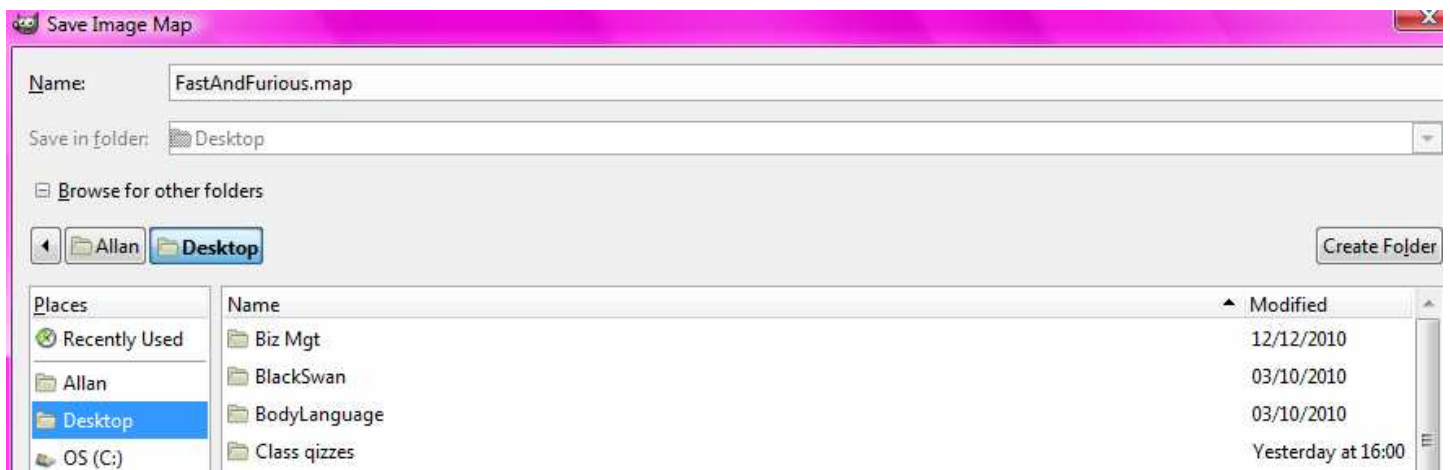
- Now use the **Define Polygon Area Tool** and draw a stencil around your shape. Again double click to finish it

- Now go to **File | Save as...** The following window appears:



- Click the **Save** button at the bottom right hand corner of the screen
- Close this window
- Now right click on the FastAndFurious.map and open it with **Notepad**
- Go to **File | Save as** and call it FastAndFurious.html
- Close the FastAndFurious.map file and double click on FastAndFurious.html and it should open in Internet Explorer (you might have to right click on it and choose to open it with Internet Explorer).
